## Where to grab drinks?

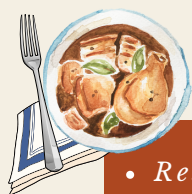
- *Folii* (wine bar) - Erstagatan 21

## Where to... Midsommar!

- *Skansen* - You can celebrate Midsommar in the center of Stockholm at Skansen, the oldest open-air museum in Sweden, where Midsommar's celebrations have been organized since the 1890s! More information can be found here: <https://skansen.se/se-och-gora/hogtider-traditioner/midsommar/>
- *Vaxholm* - One of the most popular islands to visit in the Stockholm archipelago - you can reach it either via public transport (bus) or via boat (50 minutes from the city). If you do go there, you need to stop for drinks/lunch/fika at the Vaxholms Hembygdsgårds Café!
